Originally from Chiapas, Luis Alberto and Ana Irma have only lived in Puerto Peñasco for the past few years. Luis left Chiapas looking for better employment than what he was able to find in Chiapas. He met Ana in Peñasco and they have been together for three years.

Together Luis and Ana are raising Cristina and Francisco, two of Ana's children from her previous marriage, as well as the son they had together, Luis Mateo. Ana's other daughter is currently living with her mother. The baby suffers from bronchitis, and their public insurance does not cover his medications, causing additional financial strain for the family.

Luis works in construction, and Ana has occasional work cleaning houses. The family is currently living with Luis' mother, but the conditions are crowded offering little privacy or independence for the family.

A house from 1MISSION would give this family a place where they could have all of their children together in one healthy, safe place. It would allow Luis and Ana to continue to work to meet the family's daily needs, while also building a stronger future.
